■ Authentication and Login

- Single Sign On via *My VMware* for both Developer Center and Developer Center Partner Network
- If you already have a *My VMware* account we will use it, otherwise we will automatically create a new one for you using your vmdev.net email address
- Developer Center will continue to also accept Partner Central credentials to enable you to gain access to your Server and Storage program content previously available on Partner Central.
- You will need to change your credentials in the Workbench Dashboard to your new My VMware login

FAQ

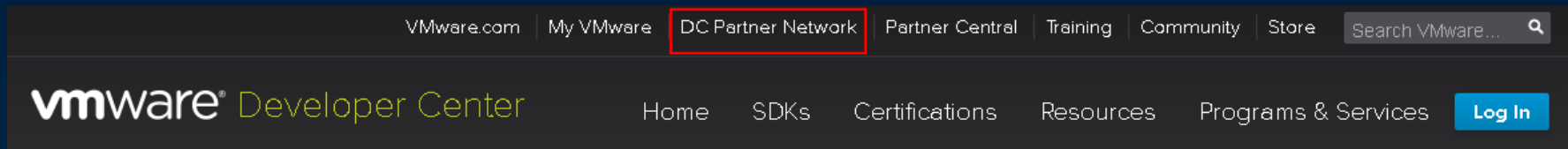
- **Does this change how I submit certifications or requests for certification support?**

 - Yes, regardless of status or age
 - Email discussions via the forums will be archived but not migrated
- **When does Developer Center Partner Network launch and when will I receive my new login information?**
 - Monday, March 17th
- **Will I still be able to access vmdev.net?**
 - vmdev.net will be put in read-only mode on Friday March 14th at 6pm PDT and will remain available for read only access through April 17th.
